

## PLANNING BOARD MINUTES

February 27, 2023

A regular meeting of the Town of Dickinson Planning Board was held on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2023 in the Town Meeting Room, Town Office Building, 531 Old Front Street, Binghamton, New York. Chairman Ford called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Also Present: Councilman Burns, Code Enforcement Officer Doyle

Adoption of the Planning Board Operating Procedures. Chairman Ford wanted to thank everyone on the Board for their hard work in getting these procedures completed. A motion was made by member Sands to accept the Operating Procedures, and 2<sup>nd</sup> by member Morello.

Chairman Ford stated he had reached out to the County Planning Office for 2020 Census information for use in the Town Comprehensive Plan update, but they had not received detailed information yet. Some website contacts were to be forwarded. He was hoping to have something by this meeting from the County, but had not heard anything back at this time.

DOT Project PIN 950123 – Pedestrian Bridge Removal is slated for the 2023 construction season. Most of the work will be done at night.

No comments from the public.

Motion to approve 1/30/23 minutes. Sands and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mickelson. All in favor.

There was a small discussion in regards to the roundabouts and some of the issues Planning Board members have seen over the last few months. The rate of speed coming into the circle seems to be too high and causing accidents. Thoughts from members were given to have the speed limits reduced coming into the roundabouts. Members suggested reaching out to the NYS DOT or the Sheriff's office to help enforce the current speed limits or have them reduced. Member Sands was asked to write up a summary of the concern discussed for Board review and forwarding to Supervisor Marinaccio for his possible action.

Motion to adjournment member Van Houten and 2<sup>nd</sup> by member Sands. All in favor.
